This puzzle 29 extra words make it fun to play.

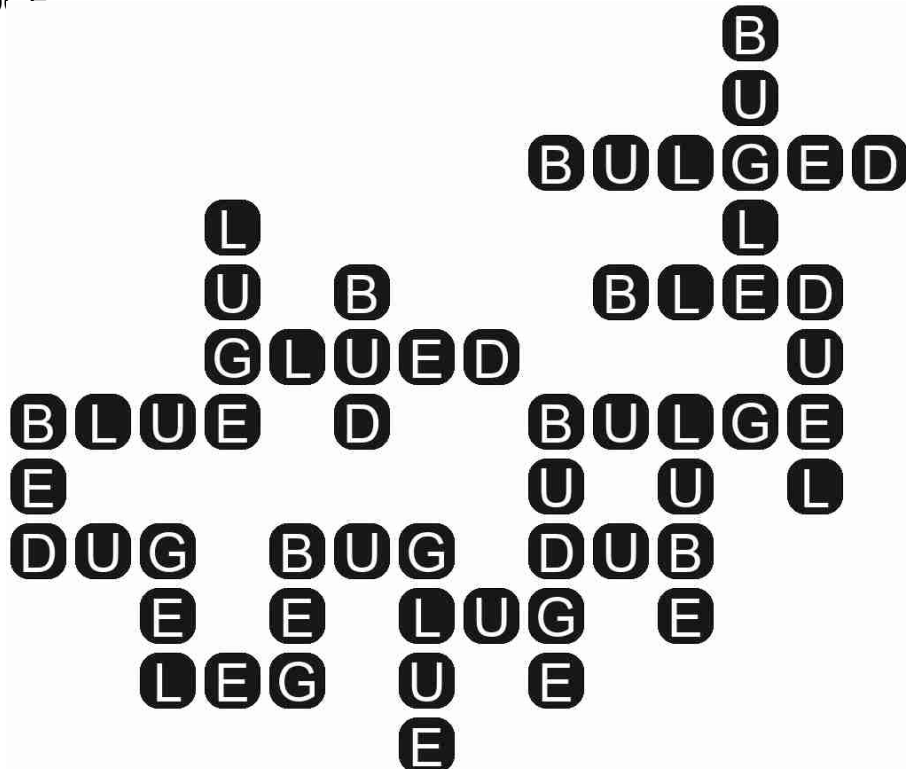
Reaching this point shows that you completed 54,015 words and 222,730 letters.

Word definitions - wordscapes level 4616

BED - A piece of furniture, usually flat and soft, to sleep on.

BEG - To request the help of someone, often in the form of money.

BUD - A newly formed leaf or flower that has not yet unfolded.

BUG - An insect of the order Hemiptera (the "true bugs").

DUG - Mammary gland on domestic mammal containing more than two breasts.

GEL - A semi-solid to almost solid colloid of a solid and a liquid, such as jelly, cheese or opal.

LEG - The lower limb of a human being or animal that extends from the groin to the ankle.

LUG - A lug nut.

DUB - To confer knighthood; the conclusion of the ceremony was marked by a tap on the shoulder with the sword.

BLUE - Having a bluish colour shade.

DUEL - Arranged, regular combat between two private persons, often over a matter of honor.

GLUE - A hard gelatin made by boiling bones and hides, used in solution as an adhesive; or any sticky adhesive substance.

LUBE - Lubricant.

BLED - Simple past tense and past participle of bleed.

LUGE - A racing sled for one or two people that is ridden with the rider or riders lying on their back.

BUDGE - To move.

BULGE - Something sticking out from a surface.

BUGLE - A simple brass instrument consisting of a horn with no valves, playing only pitches in its harmonic series.

BULGED - Simple past tense and past participle of bulge.
