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# Word definitions - wordscapes level 4618

BAKE - To cook (something) in an oven.

BARE - Minimal; that is or are just sufficient.

BARK - To make a short, loud, explosive noise with the vocal organs (said of animals, especially dogs).

BEAK - A rigid structure projecting from the front of a bird's face, used for pecking, grooming and for eating food.

BEAR - A large omnivorous mammal, related to the dog and raccoon, having shaggy hair, a very small tail, and flat feet; a member of family Ursidae, particularly of subfamily Ursinae.

RARE - Cooked very lightly, so the meat is still red (in the case of steak or beef in the general sense).

REAR - To raise physically; to lift up; to cause to rise, to elevate.

RAKE - A garden tool with a row of pointed teeth fixed to a long handle, used for collecting grass or debris, or for loosening soil.

BAKER - A person who bakes and sells bread, cakes and similar items.

BREAK - To separate into two or more pieces, to fracture or crack, by a process that cannot easily be reversed for reassembly.

BRAKE - A type of machine for bending sheet metal.

BARKER - Someone or something who barks.
