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Word definitions - wordscapes level 4626

ELM - A tree of the genus *Ulmus* of the family *Ulmaceae*, large deciduous trees with alternate stipulate leaves and small apetalous flowers.

HEM - Used to fill in the gap of a pause with a vocalized sound.

HEY - An exclamation to get attention.

HOE - An agricultural tool consisting of a long handle with a flat blade fixed perpendicular to it at the end, used for digging rows.

LYE - A strong caustic alkaline solution of potassium or sodium salts, obtained by leaching wood ashes. It is much used in making soap as well as its use in biodiesel.

OHM - In the International System of Units, the derived unit of electrical resistance; the electrical resistance of a device across which a potential difference of one volt causes a current of one ampere.

HELM - The steering apparatus of a ship, especially the tiller or wheel.

HOLE - A hollow spot in a surface.

HOLY - Dedicated to a religious purpose or a god.

HOME - One's own dwelling place; the house or structure in which one lives; especially the house in which one lives with his family; the habitual abode of one's family; also, one's birthplace.

MOLE - A pigmented spot on the skin, a naevus, slightly raised, and sometimes hairy.

HOMEY - Someone, particularly a male acquaintance, from one's hometown.

HOMELY - Lacking in beauty or elegance, plain in appearance, physically unattractive.
