This puzzle 21 extra words make it fun to play.

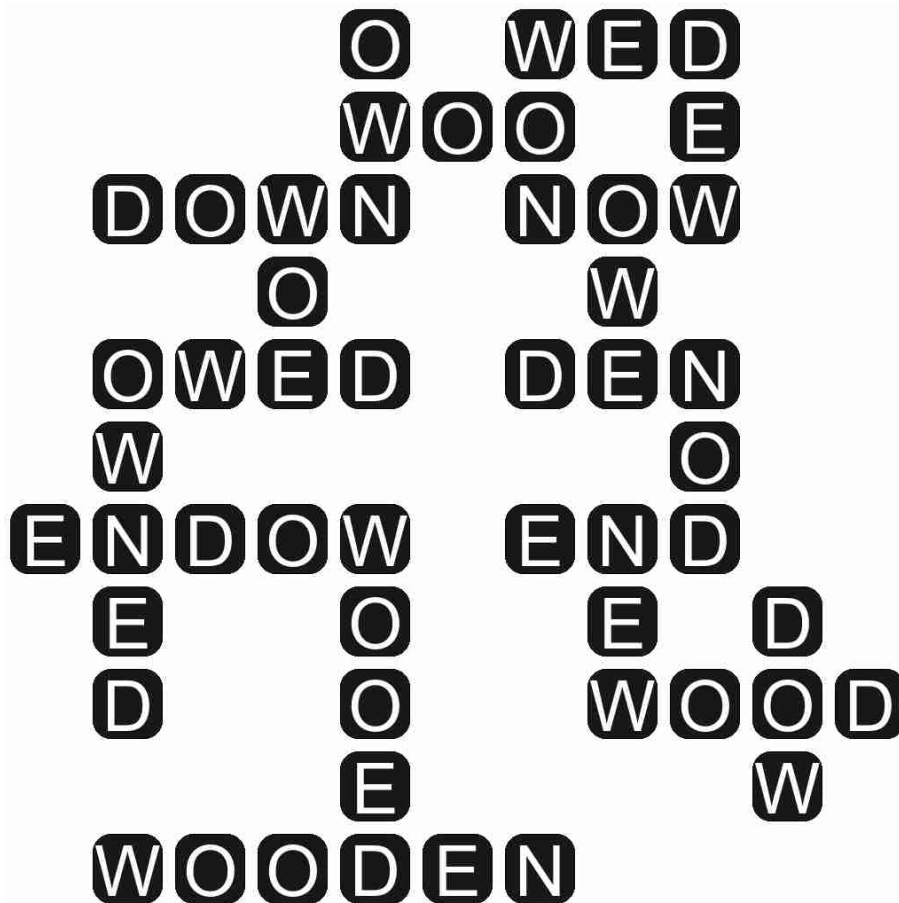
Reaching this point shows that you completed 55,207 words and 227,508 letters.

# Word definitions - wordscapes level 4714

DEN - The home of certain animals.

DEW - Moisture in the air that settles on plants, etc in the morning, resulting in drops.

END - The final point of something in space or time.

NEW - Recently made, or created.

NOD - To incline the head up and down, as to indicate agreement.

NOW - Present; current.

OWE - To be under an obligation to give something back to someone or to perform some action for someone.

OWN - To have rightful possession of (property, goods or capital); "To possess by right; to have the right of property in; to have the legal right or rightful title to."  
(Ref 1).

WON - Simple past tense and past participle of win.

DOW - To be worth.

WOO - To endeavor to gain someone's support.

WED - To perform the marriage ceremony for; to join in matrimony.

WOE - Grief; sorrow; misery; heavy calamity.

DOWN - Hill, rolling grassland.

OWED - Simple past tense and past participle of owe.

WOOD - The substance making up the central part of the trunk and branches of a tree. Used as a material for construction, to manufacture various items, etc. or as fuel.

OWNED - Simple past tense and past participle of own.

ENDOW - To furnish with money or its equivalent, as a permanent fund for support; to

ower; as, to endow a wife; to endow a public institution.

WOOED - Simple past tense and past participle of woo.

WOODEN - Made of wood: "a wooden boat".
