DEN - The home of certain animals.

END - The final point of something in space or time.

SEE - To perceive or detect with the eyes, or as if by sight.

SUE - To follow.

SUN - To expose the eyes to the sun as part of the Bates method.

USE - The act of using.

DUN - A brownish grey colour.

DUNE - A ridge or hill of sand piled up by the wind.

NEED - A requirement for something.

SEED - A fertilized grain, initially encased in a fruit, which may grow into a mature plant.

SEEN - Past participle of see.

SEND - To make something (such as an object or message) go from one place to another.

NUDE - Without clothing or other covering of the skin.

DENSE - Having relatively high density.

ENSUE - To follow (a leader, inclination etc.).

SUEDE - A type of soft leather, made from calfskin, with a brushed texture to resemble fabric, often used to make boots, clothing and fashion accessories.

ENSUED - Simple past tense and past participle of ensue.
