This puzzle 26 extra words make it fun to play.

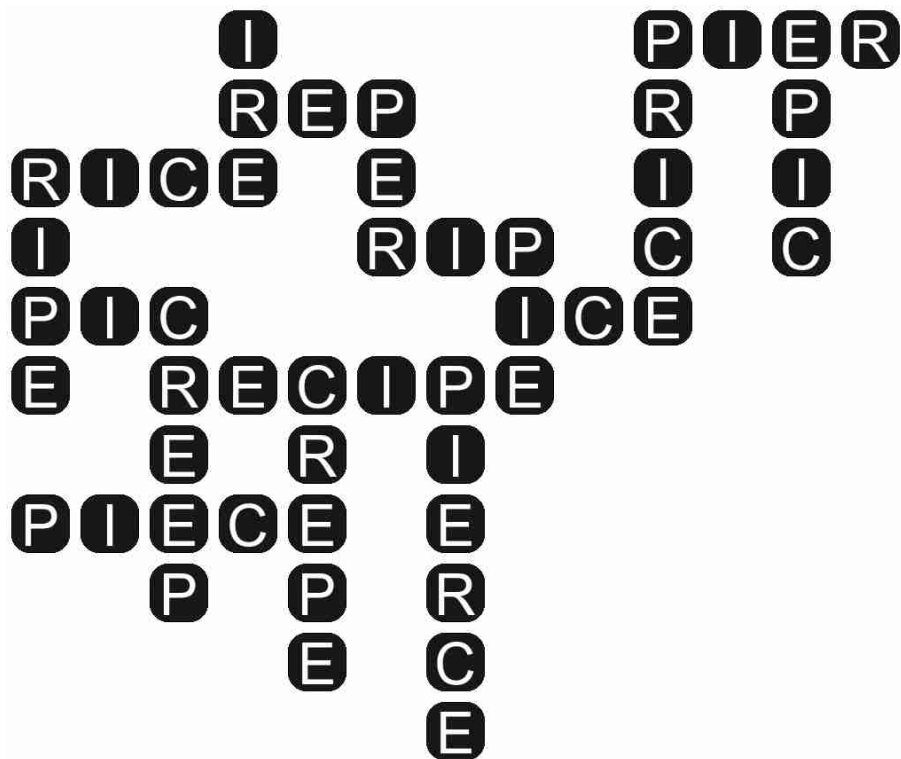
Reaching this point shows that you completed 57,973 words and 238,480 letters.

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# Word definitions - wordscapes level 4942

ICE - Water in frozen (solid) form.

PER - For each.

PIE - A type of pastry that consists of an outer crust and a filling.

RIP - A tear (in paper, etc.).

PIC - A picture, especially a photographic image.

REP - Short form of reputation.

IRE - Iron.

EPIC - An extended narrative poem in elevated or dignified language, celebrating the feats of a deity or demigod (heroic epic) or other legendary or traditional hero.

PIER - A raised platform built from the shore out over water, supported on piles; used to secure, or provide access to shipping; a jetty.

RICE - Cereal plants (*Oryza sativa*) of the grass family whose seeds are used as food.

RIPE - Ready for reaping or gathering; having attained perfection; mature; -- said of fruits, seeds, etc.; as, ripe grain.

CREEP - The movement of something that creeps (like worms or snails).

PIECE - A part of a larger whole, usually in such a form that it is able to be separated from other parts.

PRICE - The cost required to gain possession of something.

CREPE - A soft thin light fabric with a crinkled surface.

RECIPE - A set of conditions and parameters of an industrial process to obtain a given result.

PIERCE - To puncture; to break through.
