This puzzle 55 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 57,999 words and 238,585 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 4944

ELK - The largest member of the deer family (*Alces alces*); a moose.

LOB - To throw or hit a ball into the air in a high arch.

ROB - To steal from, especially using force or violence.

ORB - A spherical body; a globe; especially, one of the celestial spheres; a sun, planet, or star.

BRO - Brother; a male sibling.

COB - A male swan.

BORE - To make a hole through something.

COKE - Solid residue from roasting coal in a coke oven; used principally as a fuel and in the production of steel and formerly as a domestic fuel.

CORK - The bark of the cork oak, which is very light and porous and used for making bottle stoppers, flotation devices, and insulation material.

LOBE - Any projection or division, especially one of a somewhat rounded form.

LOCK - Something used for fastening, which can only be opened with a key or combination.

ROBE - A long loose outer garment, often signifying honorary stature.

ROCK - The naturally occurring aggregate of solid mineral matter that constitutes a significant part of the earth's crust.

LORE - All the facts and traditions about a particular subject that have been accumulated over time through education or experience.

BLOCK - A substantial, often approximately cuboid, piece of any substance.

BROKE - Lacking money; bankrupt.

CLERK - One who occupationally works with records, accounts, letters, etc.; an office worker.

LOCKER - A type of storage compartment with a lock usually used to store clothing, equipment, or books.

BLOCKER - Agent noun of block; something that blocks something specific.
