This puzzle 16 extra words make it cool to play.

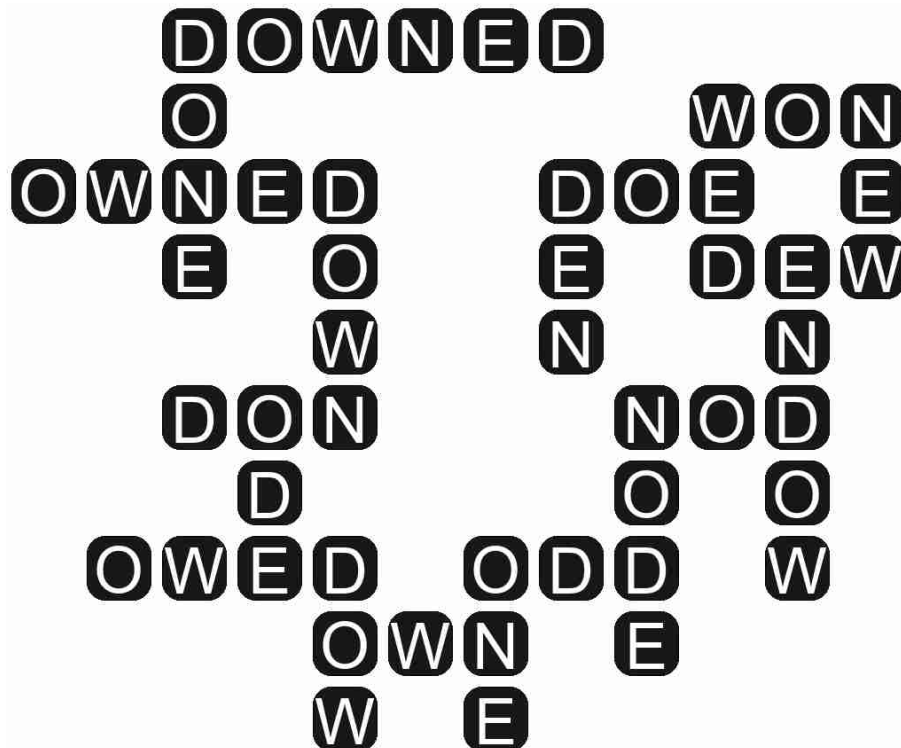
Reaching this point shows that you completed 59,023 words and 242,660 letters.

Word definitions - wordscapes level 5028

DEN - The home of certain animals.

DEW - Moisture in the air that settles on plants, etc in the morning, resulting in droplets.

NEW - Recently made, or created.

NOD - To incline the head up and down, as to indicate agreement.

ODD - Single; sole; singular; not having a mate.

ONE - A numerical value equal to 1; the first number in the set of natural numbers (especially in number theory); the cardinality of the smallest nonempty set. Ordinal: first.

OWN - To have rightful possession of (property, goods or capital); "To possess by right; to have the right of property in; to have the legal right or rightful title to." (Ref 1).

WON - Simple past tense and past participle of win.

DOE - A female deer; also used of similar animals such as reindeer, antelope, goat.

DOW - To be worth.

ODE - A short poetical composition proper to be set to music or sung; a lyric poem; especially, now, a poem characterized by sustained noble sentiment and appropriate dignity of style.

WED - To perform the marriage ceremony for; to join in matrimony.

DON - A university professor, particularly one at Oxford or Cambridge.

DONE - Ready, fully cooked.

DOWN - Hill, rolling grassland.

NODE - A knot, knob, protuberance or swelling.

OWED - Simple past tense and past participle of owe.

OWNED - Simple past tense and past participle of own.

ENDOW - To furnish with money or its equivalent, as a permanent fund for support; to make pecuniary provision for; to settle an income upon; especially, to furnish with dower; as, to endow a wife; to endow a public institution.

DOWNED - Simple past tense and past participle of down.
