This puzzle 46 extra words make it fun to play.

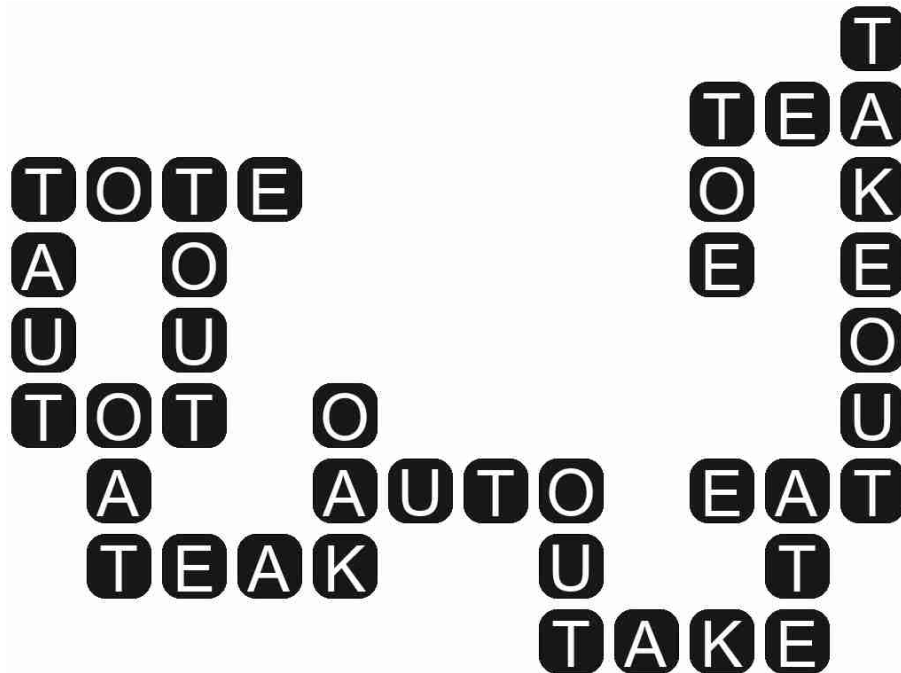
Reaching this point shows that you completed 60,432 words and 248,216 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 5146

ATE - Simple past of eat.

EAT - To consume (something solid or semi-solid, usually food) by putting it into the mouth and swallowing it.

OAK - A tree of the genus *Quercus*.

OUT - Away from home or one's usual place, or not indoors.

TEA - The dried leaves or buds of the tea plant, *Camellia sinensis*.

TOE - Each of the five digits on the end of the foot.

OAT - Widely cultivated cereal grass, typically *Avena sativa*.

TOT - A small child.

AUTO - An automobile.

TAKE - To grasp with the hands.

TAUT - Tight; under tension, as in a rope or bow string.

TEAK - An extremely durable timber highly valued for shipbuilding and other purposes, yielded by *Tectona grandis* (and *Tectona* spp.).

TOTE - A bag, specifically a tote bag.

TOUT - Someone advertising for customers in an aggressive way.

TAKEOUT - Intended to be eaten off the premises.
