This puzzle 19 extra words make it fun to play.

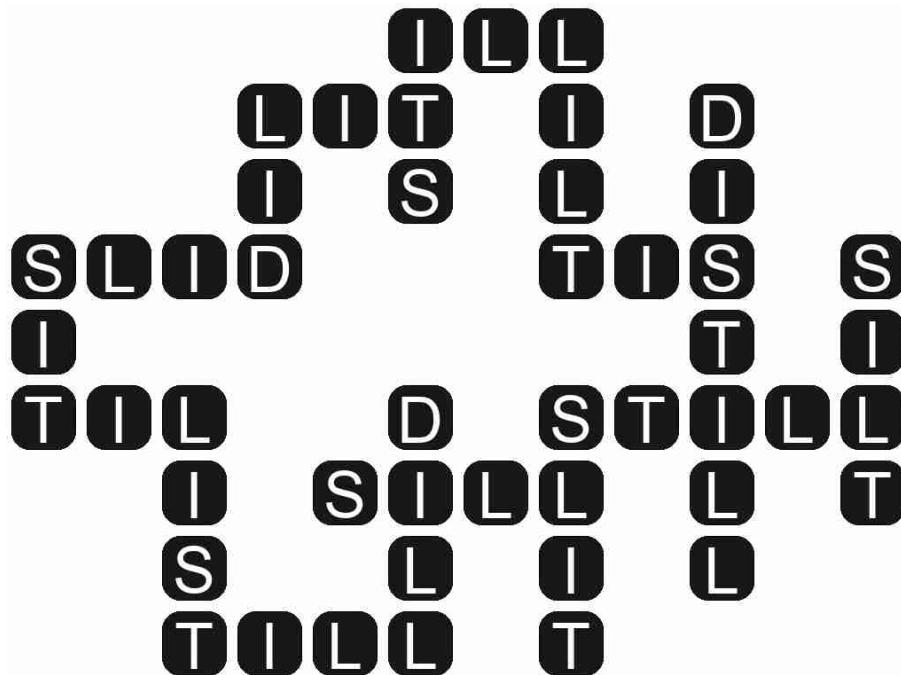
Reaching this point shows that you completed 61,221 words and 251,383 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 5210

ILL - Extremely bad (bad enough to make one ill). Generally used indirectly with to be.

ITS - The one (or ones) belonging to it.

LID - The top or cover of a container.

LIT - Little.

SIT - To be in a position in which the upper body is upright and the legs (especially the upper legs) are supported by some object.

TIS - Plural of til.

TIL - Until, till.

DILL - *Anethum graveolens* (the sole species of the genus *Anethum*), is a herb, the seeds of which are moderately warming, pungent, and aromatic, and were formerly used as a soothing medicine for children; also known as dillseed.

LIST - A strip of fabric, especially from the edge of a piece of cloth.

SLID - Simple past tense and past participle of slide.

TILL - To.

LILT - To do something rhythmically, with animation and quickness, usually of music.

SILL - A horizontal slat which forms the base of a window.

SILT - Mud or fine earth deposited from running or standing water.

SLIT - A narrow cut or opening; a slot.

STILL - Not moving; calm.

DISTILL - To subject a substance to distillation.
