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# Word definitions - wordscapes level 5221

ARC - A directed edge.

CAP - A close-fitting head covering either without a brim or with a peak.

CAR - A wheeled vehicle, drawn by a horse or other animal.

CRY - To shed tears; to weep.

ICY - Pertaining to, resembling, or abounding in ice; cold; frosty.

PAR - By; with.

PAY - To give money or other compensation to in exchange for goods or services.

PRY - To look where one is not welcome; to be nosey.

RAP - A sharp blow with something hard.

RIP - A tear (in paper, etc.).

PIC - A picture, especially a photographic image.

CAY - A small, low island largely made of sand or coral.

PAIR - Two similar or identical things taken together; often followed by of.

PRAY - To petition or solicit help from a supernatural or higher being.

CARP - Any of various freshwater fish of the family Cyprinidae, especially the common carp, *Cyprinus carpio*.

RACY - Having a strong flavor indicating origin; of distinct characteristic taste; tasting of the soil; hence, fresh; rich.

PIRACY - Robbery at sea, a violation of international law; taking a ship away from the control of those who are legally entitled to it.
