This puzzle 11 extra words make it cool to play.

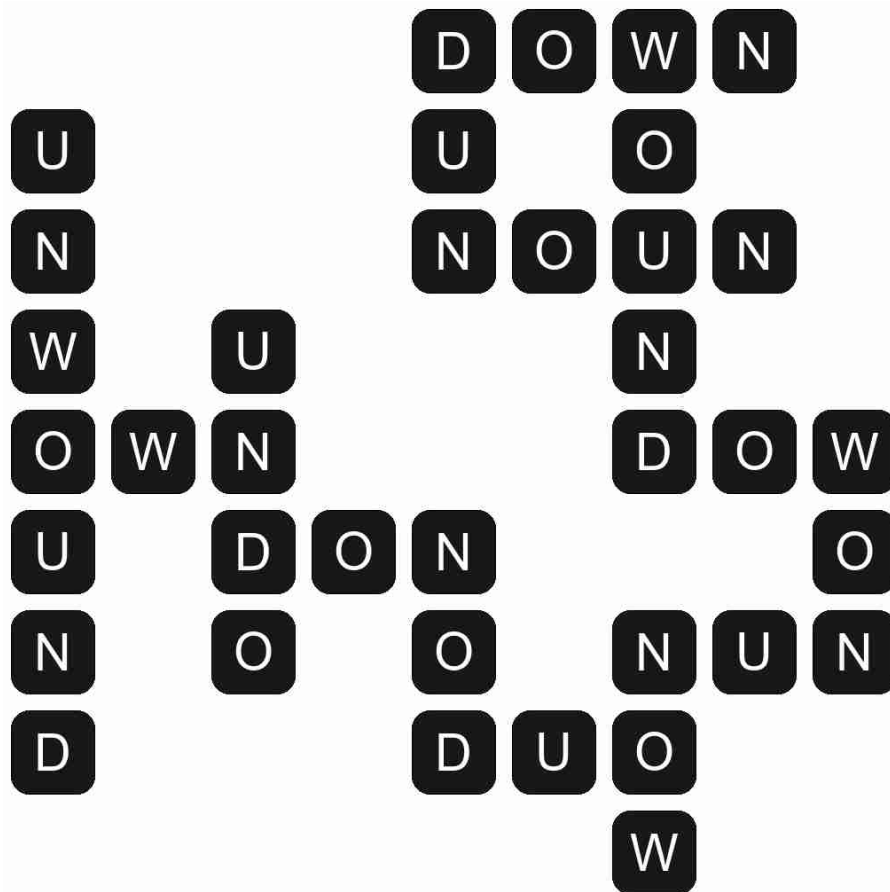
Reaching this point shows that you completed 62,078 words and 254,814 letters.

Word definitions - wordscapes level 5280

DUO - A twosome, especially musicians.

NOD - To incline the head up and down, as to indicate agreement.

NOW - Present; current.

NUN - A member of a Christian religious community of women who live by certain vows and usually wear a habit, in some cases living together in a cloister.

OWN - To have rightful possession of (property, goods or capital); "To possess by right; to have the right of property in; to have the legal right or rightful title to."
(Ref 1).

WON - Simple past tense and past participle of win.

DOW - To be worth.

DUN - A brownish grey colour.

DON - A university professor, particularly one at Oxford or Cambridge.

DOWN - Hill, rolling grassland.

UNDO - To reverse the effects of an action.

NOUN - A word that can be used to refer to a person, animal, place, thing, phenomenon, substance, quality, or idea; one of the basic parts of speech in many languages, including English.

WOUND - An injury, such as a cut, stab, or tear, to a (usually external) part of the body.

UNWOUND - Simple past tense and past participle of unwind.
