This puzzle 47 extra words make it fun to play.

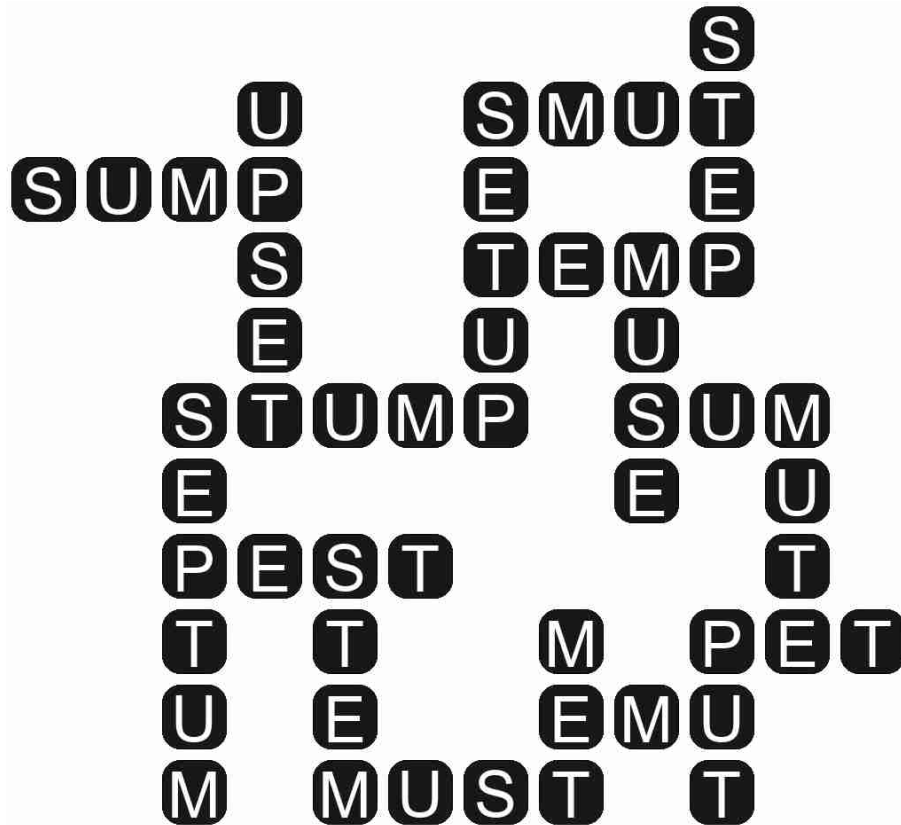
Reaching this point shows that you completed 62,736 words and 257,413 letters.

Word definitions - wordscapes level 5332

MET - Simple past tense and past participle of meet.

PET - An animal kept as a companion.

PUT - To place something somewhere.

SUM - A quantity obtained by addition or aggregation.

EMU - A large flightless bird native to Australia, *Dromaius novaehollandiae*.

MUST - To do with certainty; indicates that the speaker is certain that the subject will have executed the predicate.

MUTE - To silence, to make quiet.

PEST - A plague, pestilence, epidemic.

STEM - The above-ground stalk (technically axis) of a vascular plant, and certain anatomically similar, below-ground organs such as rhizomes, bulbs, tubers, and corms.

STEP - To move the foot in walking; to advance or recede by raising and moving one of the feet to another resting place, or by moving both feet in succession.

MUSE - A source of inspiration.

TEMP - A temporary employee, usually in an office.

SMUT - Soot.

SUMP - A hollow or pit into which liquid drains, such as a cesspool, cesspit or sink.

SETUP - Equipment designed for a particular purpose; an apparatus.

STUMP - The remains of something that has been cut off; especially the remains of a tree, the remains of a limb.

UPSET - Angry, distressed, or unhappy.

SEPTUM - A wall separating two cavities; a partition; as, the nasal septum.
