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Word definitions - wordscapes level 5354

RIB - Any of a series of long curved bones occurring in 12 pairs in humans and other animals and extending from the spine to or toward the sternum.

RIM - An edge around something, especially when circular.

MIL - An angular mil, a unit of angular measurement equal to 1/6400 of a complete circle. At 1000 metres one mil subtends about one metre (0.98 m). Also 1/6000 and 1/6300 are used in other countries.

REM - Rapid eye movement, a sleep state.

LIMB - A major appendage of human or animal, used for locomotion (such as an arm, leg or wing).

LIME - A general term for inorganic materials containing calcium, usually calcium oxide or calcium hydroxide; quicklime.

MILE - A Roman unit of measure equal to 1000 (double) steps (mille passus or mille passuum) or 5000 Roman feet (approx. 1480m).

BRIM - The sea; ocean; water; flood.

BILE - A bitter brownish-yellow or greenish-yellow secretion produced by the liver, stored in the gall bladder, and discharged into the duodenum where it aids the process of digestion.

BERM - A narrow ledge or shelf, as along the top or bottom of a slope.

BRIE - A variety of soft, mild French cheese made from cow's milk.

MIRE - Deep mud; moist, spongy earth.

LIMBER - Flexible, pliant, bendable.
