This puzzle 19 extra words make it fun to play.

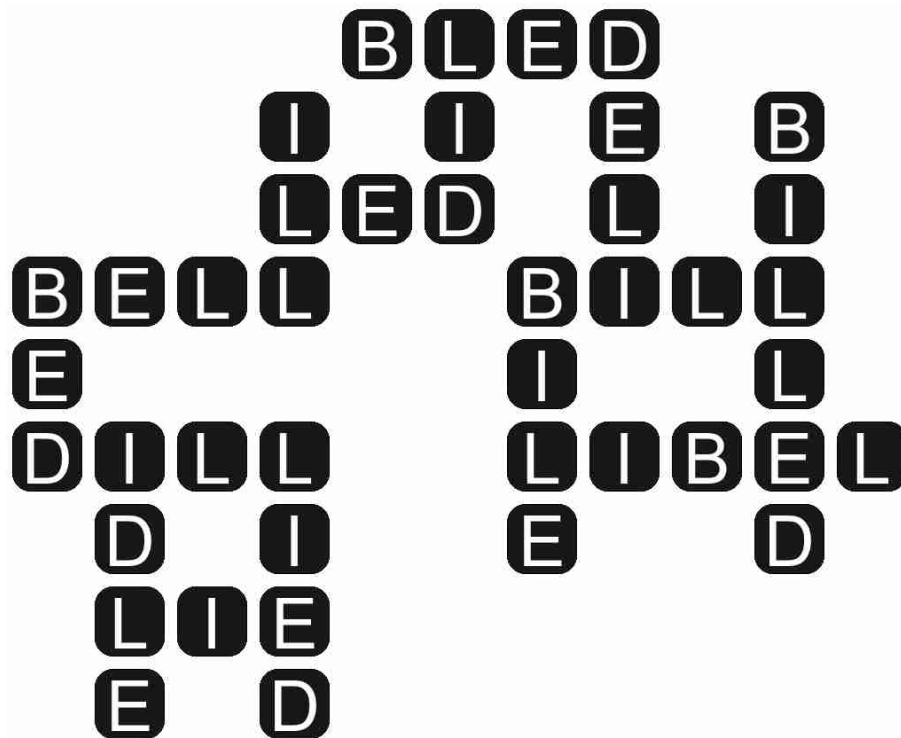
Reaching this point shows that you completed 5,747 words and 22,886 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 536

BED - A piece of furniture, usually flat and soft, to sleep on.

ILL - Extremely bad (bad enough to make one ill). Generally used indirectly with to be.

LED - Simple past tense and past participle of lead.

LID - The top or cover of a container.

LIE - To be in a horizontal position.

BELL - A percussive instrument made of metal or other hard material, typically but not always in the shape of an inverted cup with a flared rim, which resonates when struck.

BILL - Any of various bladed or pointed hand weapons, originally designating an Anglo-Saxon sword, and later a weapon of infantry, especially in the 14th and 15th centuries, commonly consisting of a broad, heavy, double-edged, hook-shaped blade, with a short pike at the back and another at the top, attached to the end of a long staff.

DILL - *Anethum graveolens* (the sole species of the genus *Anethum*), is a herb, the seeds of which are moderately warming, pungent, and aromatic, and were formerly used as a soothing medicine for children; also known as dillseed.

LIED - An art song, sung in German and accompanied on the piano.

DELI - A shop that sells cooked or prepared food ready for serving.

IDLE - Empty, vacant.

BILE - A bitter brownish-yellow or greenish-yellow secretion produced by the liver, stored in the gall bladder, and discharged into the duodenum where it aids the process of digestion.

BLED - Simple past tense and past participle of bleed.

LIBEL - A written (notably as handbill) or pictorial statement which unjustly seeks to damage someone's reputation.

BILLED - Simple past tense and past participle of bill.

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
