Word definitions - wordscapes level 5384

ALE - An intoxicating liquor made from an infusion of malt by fermentation and the addition of a bitter, usually hops.

ARE - Second-person singular simple present tense of be.

BAR - A solid, more or less rigid object with a uniform cross-section smaller than its length.

BRA - A brassiere.

EAR - The organ of hearing, consisting of the pinna, auditory canal, eardrum, malleus, incus, stapes and cochlea.

ERA - A time period of indeterminate length, generally more than one year.

LAB - A laboratory.

ABLE - A word that is used in place of the letter "A" during communication.

BARE - Minimal; that is or are just sufficient.

EARL - A British nobleman next in rank above a viscount and below a marquess; equivalent to a European count. A female using the style is termed a countess.

REAL - A commodity; see reality.

VEAL - The flesh of a calf used for food.

VERB - A word that indicates an action, event, or state.

BALE - Evil, especially considered as an active force for destruction or death.

RAVE - An enthusiastic review (such as of a play).

VALE - Valley.

BRAVE - Strong in the face of fear; courageous.

BLARE - A loud sound.
