This puzzle 30 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 64,142 words and 263,013 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 5448

ORE - Rock that contains utilitarian materials; primarily a rock containing metals or gems which (at the time of the rock's evaluation and proposal for extraction) are able to be separated from its neighboring minerals and processed at a cost that does not exceed those materials' present-day economic values.

EEL - Any fish of the order Anguilliformes which are elongated and resemble snakes. There are freshwater and marine species.

LOVE - An intense feeling of affection and care towards another person.

OVER - In radio communications: end of sentence, ready to receive reply.

REEL - A lively dance of the Highlanders of Scotland; also, the music to the dance; - often called Scotch reel.

ROLE - A character or part played by a performer or actor.

LEER - A significant side glance; a glance expressive of some passion, as malignity, amorousness, etc.; a sly or lecherous look.

LORE - All the facts and traditions about a particular subject that have been accumulated over time through education or experience.

ROVE - To shoot with arrows (at).

VOLE - Any of a large number of species of small rodents of the family Cricetidae.

LEVER - A rigid piece which is capable of turning about one point, or axis (the fulcrum), and in which are two or more other points where forces are applied (used for transmitting and modifying force and motion).

LOVER - A person who deeply and strongly loves and cares for another person in a romantic way, a sweetheart, love, soul-mate, boyfriend, or girlfriend.

REVEL - An instance of merrymaking; a celebration.

VERVE - Excitement of imagination such as that which animates a poet, artist, or musician, in composing or performing.

EVOLVE - To move in regular procession through a system.
