This puzzle 22 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 5,961 words and 23,706 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 552

LOT - A large quantity or number; a great deal.

OUT - Away from home or one's usual place, or not indoors.

TOO - Likewise.

COT - A symbol of the trigonometric function cotangent.

COOK - A person who prepares food for a living.

COOL - Having a slightly low temperature; mildly or pleasantly cold.

CULT - A group of people with a religious, philosophical or cultural identity sometimes viewed as a sect, often existing on the margins of society or exploitative towards its members.

LOCK - Something used for fastening, which can only be opened with a key or combination.

LOOK - To try to see, to pay attention to with one's eyes.

LUCK - Something that happens to someone by chance, a chance occurrence.

TOOK - Simple past of take.

TOOL - A mechanical device intended to make a task easier.

TUCK - To fit neatly.

CLOT - A solidified mass of blood.

COLT - A young male horse.

LOOT - Plunder, booty, especially from a ransacked city.

CLOUT - Influence or effectiveness, especially political.

LOCKOUT - The opposite of a strike, a labor disruption where management refuses to allow workers into a plant to work even if they are willing.
