DICE - Plural form of die.

DINE - To eat; to eat dinner or supper.

ICED - With ice added.

NICE - Nicely.

WIDE - Having a large physical extent from side to side.

WIND - Real or perceived movement of atmospheric air usually caused by convection or differences in air pressure.

WINE - An alcoholic beverage made by fermenting juice of grapes.

WIDEN - To become wide or wider.

WINCE - A sudden movement or gesture of shrinking away.

WINCED - Simple past tense and past participle of wince.
