This puzzle 51 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 68,696 words and 281,158 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 5824

DIP - A lower section of a road or geological feature.

KID - A young goat.

PIE - A type of pastry that consists of an outer crust and a filling.

SIP - A small mouthful of drink.

SKI - One of a pair of long flat runners designed for gliding over snow.

DESK - A table, frame, or case, usually with sloping top, but often with flat top, for the use of writers and readers. It often has a drawer or repository underneath.

DISK - A thin, flat, circular plate or similar object.

SIDE - A bounding straight edge of a two-dimensional shape.

SKIP - To move by hopping on alternate feet.

SPED - Simple past tense and past participle of speed.

SKID - An out-of-control sliding motion as would result from applying the brakes too hard in a car.

DIKE - The northern English form of ditch.

PIKE - A very long thrusting spear used two-handed by infantry both for attacks on enemy foot soldiers and as a counter-measure against cavalry assaults. The pike is not intended to be thrown.

SPIKE - A sort of very large nail; also, a piece of pointed iron set with points upward or outward.

SPIED - Simple past tense and past participle of spy.

SPIKED - Containing alcohol or drugs, often without the informing those who partake.
