This puzzle 55 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 68,819 words and 281,638 letters.

DOT - A small spot.

MET - Simple past tense and past participle of meet.

SET - To put (something) down, to rest.

SOD - That stratum of the surface of the soil which is filled with the roots of grass, or any portion of that surface; turf; sward.

TOE - Each of the five digits on the end of the foot.

DOE - A female deer; also used of similar animals such as reindeer, antelope, goat.

ODE - A short poetical composition proper to be set to music or sung; a lyric poem; esp., now, a poem characterized by sustained noble sentiment and appropriate dignity of style.

DEMO - A brief demonstration or visual explanation.

DOME - A common structural element of architecture that resembles the hollow upper half of a sphere, a cupola.

DOSE - A measured portion of medicine taken at any one time.

MODE - One of several ancient scales, one of which corresponds to the modern major scale and one to the natural minor scale.

MOST - Superlative form of much.

SOME - A certain number, at least one.

STEM - The above-ground stalk (technically axis) of a vascular plant, and certain anatomically similar, below-ground organs such as rhizomes, bulbs, tubers, and corms.

TOME - One in a series of volumes.

DOTE - To be excessively fond of.

MOTE - A small particle; a speck.
