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# Word definitions - wordscapes level 584

ALE - An intoxicating liquor made from an infusion of malt by fermentation and the addition of a bitter, usually hops.

ALL - Intensifier.

AYE - Ever, always.

BEE - A flying insect, of the superfamily Apoidea, known for their organised societies, for collecting pollen, and producing wax and honey.

BYE - The position of a person or team in a tournament or competition who draws no opponent in a particular round so advances to the next round unopposed, or is awarded points for a win in a league table; also the phantom opponent of such a person or team.

EYE - An organ that is sensitive to light, which it converts to electrical signals passed to the brain, by which means animals see.

LAB - A laboratory.

LAY - To place down in a position of rest, or in a horizontal position.

YEA - Yes.

ABLE - A word that is used in place of the letter "A" during communication.

ALLY - To unite, or form a connection between, as between families by marriage, or between princes and states by treaty, league, or confederacy.

BALL - A solid or hollow sphere.

BELL - A percussive instrument made of metal or other hard material, typically but not always in the shape of an inverted cup with a flared rim, which resonates when struck.

YELL - Shout; holler; make a loud sound with the voice.

BALE - Evil, especially considered as an active force for destruction or death.

ABLY - In an able manner; with great ability.

ALLEY - A narrow street or passageway, especially one through the middle of a block giving access to the rear of lots or buildings.

BELLY - The abdomen.

LABEL - A small ticket or sign giving information about something to which it is attached or intended to be attached.

EYEBALL - The ball of the eye.
