Word definitions - wordscapes level 5904

ALE - An intoxicating liquor made from an infusion of malt by fermentation and the addition of a bitter, usually hops.

APE - A primate of the clade Hominoidea, generally larger than monkeys and distinguished from them by having no tail.

APP - An application (program), especially a small one designed for a mobile device.

LAP - The loose part of a coat; the lower part of a garment that plays loosely; a skirt; an apron.

PAL - A friend, buddy, mate, cobbler, someone to hang around with.

PEA - A plant, member of the legume (Fabaceae) family.

PEP - To inject with energy and enthusiasm.

PAP - Food in the form of a soft paste, often a porridge, especially as given to very young children.

LEAP - To jump from one location to another.

PALE - Light in color.

PAPA - Dad, daddy, father; a familiar or old-fashioned term of address to one's father.

PLEA - An appeal, petition, urgent prayer or entreaty.

PEAL - A loud sound, or a succession of loud sounds, as of bells, thunder, cannon, shouts, laughter, of a multitude, etc.

APPLE - A common, round fruit produced by the tree *Malus domestica*, cultivated in temperate climates.

PAPAL - Having to do with the pope or the papacy.

APPEAL - To accuse (someone of something).
