This puzzle 18 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 70,570 words and 288,562 letters.

The extra or bonus words are:

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 5978

ARE - Second-person singular simple present tense of be.

ARM - The portion of the upper human appendage, from the shoulder to the wrist and so metimes including the hand.

EAR - The organ of hearing, consisting of the pinna, auditory canal, eardrum, malleus , incus, stapes and cochlea.

ERA - A time period of indeterminate length, generally more than one year.

HAM - The region back of the knee joint; the popliteal space; the hock.

HEM - Used to fill in the gap of a pause with a vocalized sound.

HER - Belonging to her.

MAR - To spoil, to damage.

RAM - A male sheep.

MAM - Diminutive of mother.

HARE - Any of several plant-eating animals of the family Leporidae, especially of the genus Lepus, similar to a rabbit, but larger and with longer ears.

HARM - Injury; hurt; damage; detriment; misfortune.

HEAR - To sympathize with; to share the feeling or opinion of.

MARE - An adult female horse.

AHEM - The sound of a quiet cough or of clearing one's throat.

HAREM - The private part of an Arab household. In traditional Arab culture, this part of the household was forbidden to male strangers.

HAMMER - A tool with a heavy head and a handle used for pounding.
