This puzzle 23 extra words make it fun to play.

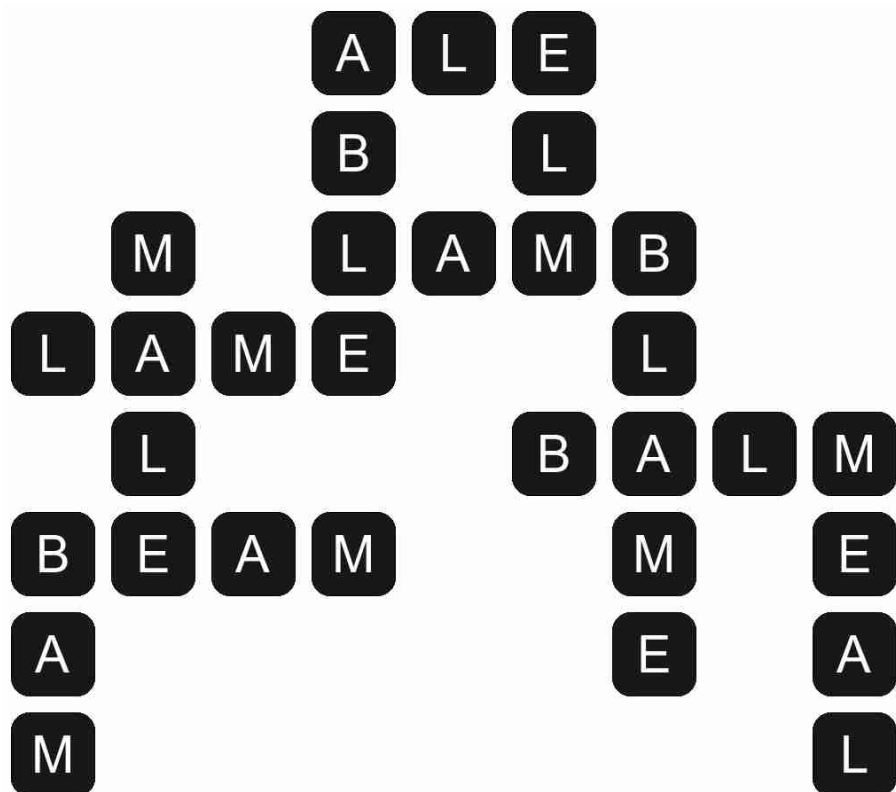
Reaching this point shows that you completed 427 words and 1,530 letters.

The words included in this word game are:

ALE, ELM, BAM, ABLE, BALM, BEAM, LAMB, LAME, MALE, MEAL, BLAME.

The extra or bonus words are:

BEMA, BAL, LAM, ALBE, BEAL, MELBA, BLAE, LEA, BLAM, BALE, MAL, AMBLE, LAB, LEAM, ALME, ALB, MAE, MABE, MELA, BAEL, AME, MEL, BEL.



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Word definitions - wordscapes level 63

ALE - An intoxicating liquor made from an infusion of malt by fermentation and the addition of a bitter, usually hops.

ELM - A tree of the genus *Ulmus* of the family *Ulmaceae*, large deciduous trees with alternate stipulate leaves and small apetalous flowers.

BAM - Representing a loud noise or heavy impact.

ABLE - A word that is used in place of the letter "A" during communication.

BALM - Any of various aromatic resins exuded from certain plants, especially trees of the genus *Commiphora* of Africa, Arabia and India and *Myroxylon* of South America.

BEAM - Any large piece of timber or iron long in proportion to its thickness, and prepared for use.

LAMB - A young sheep, of up to one year of age.

LAME - Unable to walk properly because of a problem with one's feet or legs.

MALE - Someone of male (masculine) gender.

MEAL - Food that is prepared and eaten, usually at a specific time (e.g. breakfast = morning meal, lunch = noon meal, etc).

BLAME - Censure.
