Word definitions - wordscapes level 667

AGE - The whole duration of a being, whether animal, vegetable, or other kind; lifetime.

AWE - A feeling of fear and reverence.

EGG - An approximately spherical or ellipsoidal body produced by birds, snakes, insects and other animals housing the embryo during its development.

GAG - A device to restrain speech, such as a rag in the mouth secured with tape or a rubber ball threaded onto a cord or strap.

WAD - An amorphous, compact mass.

WAG - To swing from side to side, especially of an animal's tail.

AGED - Old.

WADE - To walk through water or something that impedes progress.

WAGE - An amount of money paid to a worker for a specified quantity of work, usually expressed on an hourly basis.

AWED - Simple past tense and past participle of awe.

WAGED - Simple past tense and past participle of wage.

WAGGED - Simple past tense and past participle of wag.
