

Word definitions - wordscapes level 672

AID - Help; assistance; succor, relief.

DIG - To move hard-packed earth out of the way, especially downward to make a hole with a shovel. Or to drill, or the like, through rocks, roads, or the like. More generally, to make any similar hole by moving material out of the way.

GAL - A gallon.

LAG - Late.

LIT - Little.

TAD - A small amount; a little bit.

TAG - A small label.

GIT - A contemptible person.

AIL - Painful; troublesome.

ALT - A state of excitement, conveyed by a high pitched voice.

LAT - A Latvian coin and national monetary unit.

DIAL - A graduated, circular scale over which a needle moves to show a measurement (such as speed).

GLAD - Pleased, happy, satisfied.

LAID - Simple past tense and past participle of lay.

TAIL - The caudal appendage of an animal that is attached to its posterior and near the anus.

GAIT - Manner of walking or stepping; bearing or carriage while moving.

GILT - Gold or other metal in a thin layer; gilding.

TIDAL - Relating to tides.
