

Word definitions - wordscapes level 688

ARE - Second-person singular simple present tense of be.

ARK - A large box with a flat lid.

AWE - A feeling of fear and reverence.

EAR - The organ of hearing, consisting of the pinna, auditory canal, eardrum, malleus, incus, stapes and cochlea.

ERA - A time period of indeterminate length, generally more than one year.

RAW - Of weather: unpleasantly damp or cold.

WAR - Organized, large-scale, armed conflict between countries or between national, ethnic, or other sizeable groups, usually involving the engagement of military forces.

EEK - Representing a scream or shriek (especially in comic strips).

EKE - To increase; to add to, augment, lengthen.

WAKE - (often followed by up) To stop sleeping.

WEAK - Lacking in force (usually strength) or ability.

WEAR - To guard; watch; keep watch, especially from entry or invasion.

WEEK - Any period of seven consecutive days.

WERE - Second-person singular simple past tense indicative of be.

REEK - A strong unpleasant smell.

RAKE - A garden tool with a row of pointed teeth fixed to a long handle, used for collecting grass or debris, or for loosening soil.

WREAK - To cause, inflict or let out, especially if causing harm or injury.

WEAKER - Comparative form of weak: more weak.
