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Word definitions - wordscapes level 692

AIR - The atmospheric substance above the surface of the earth which animals breathe, formerly considered to be a single substance, one of the four basic elements of ancient philosophy and one of the five basic elements of Eastern traditions.

ART - Human effort to imitate, supplement, alter, or counteract the work of nature.

ITS - The one (or ones) belonging to it.

RAT - A medium-sized rodent belonging to the genus Rattus.

SAT - Simple past tense and past participle of sit.

SIR - A man of a higher rank or position.

SIT - To be in a position in which the upper body is upright and the legs (especially the upper legs) are supported by some object.

TAR - A black, oily, sticky, viscous substance, consisting mainly of hydrocarbons derived from organic materials such as wood, peat, or coal.

TIS - Plural of til.

STAR - Any small luminous dot appearing in the cloudless portion of the night sky, especially with a fixed location relative to other such dots.

STIR - To change the place of in any manner; to move.

TART - Sharp to the taste; acid; sour.

STAT - Immediately, now (usually used in medical situations, to connote extreme urgency).

STAIR - A single step in a staircase.

START - The beginning of an activity.

TRAIT - An identifying characteristic, habit or trend.

ARTIST - A person who creates art.

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
