This puzzle 26 extra words make it fun to play.

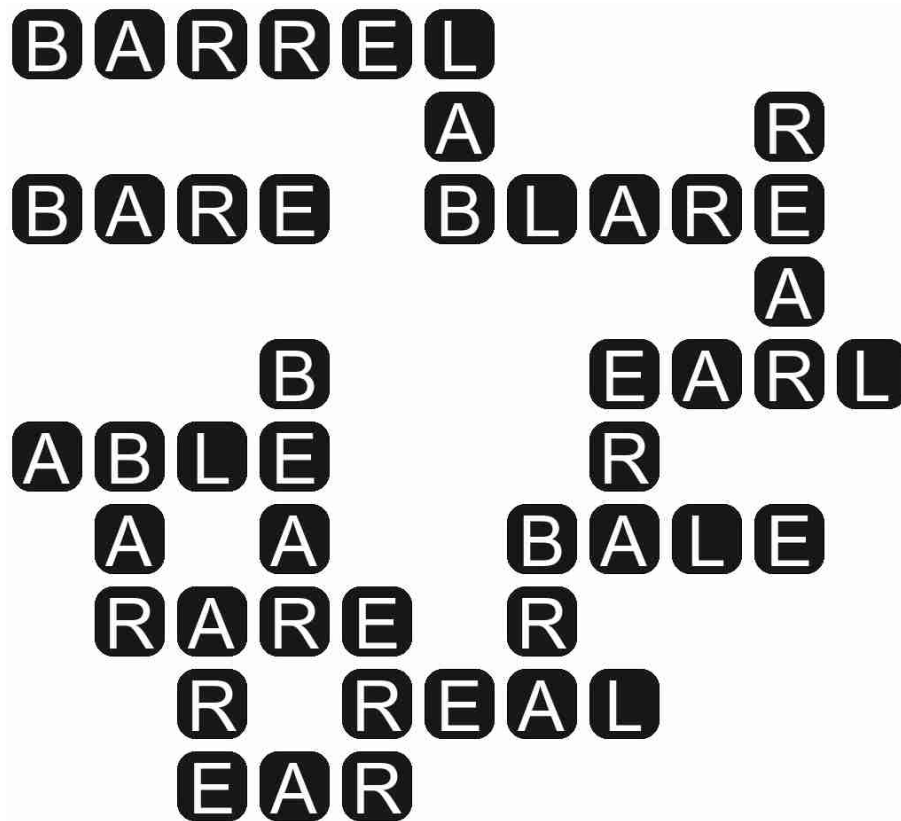
Reaching this point shows that you completed 7,812 words and 30,993 letters.

Word definitions - wordscapes level 706

ARE - Second-person singular simple present tense of be.

BAR - A solid, more or less rigid object with a uniform cross-section smaller than its length.

BRA - A brassiere.

EAR - The organ of hearing, consisting of the pinna, auditory canal, eardrum, malleus, incus, stapes and cochlea.

ERA - A time period of indeterminate length, generally more than one year.

LAB - A laboratory.

ERR - To make a mistake.

ABLE - A word that is used in place of the letter "A" during communication.

BARE - Minimal; that is or are just sufficient.

BEAR - A large omnivorous mammal, related to the dog and raccoon, having shaggy hair, a very small tail, and flat feet; a member of family Ursidae, particularly of subfamily Ursinae.

EARL - A British nobleman next in rank above a viscount and below a marquess; equivalent to a European count. A female using the style is termed a countess.

RARE - Cooked very lightly, so the meat is still red (in the case of steak or beef in the general sense).

REAL - A commodity; see reality.

REAR - To raise physically; to lift up; to cause to rise, to elevate.

BALE - Evil, especially considered as an active force for destruction or death.

BLARE - A loud sound.

BARREL - A round vessel or cask, of greater length than breadth, and bulging in the middle, made of staves bound with hoops, and having flat ends or heads. Sometimes appl
