This puzzle 26 extra words make it fun to play.

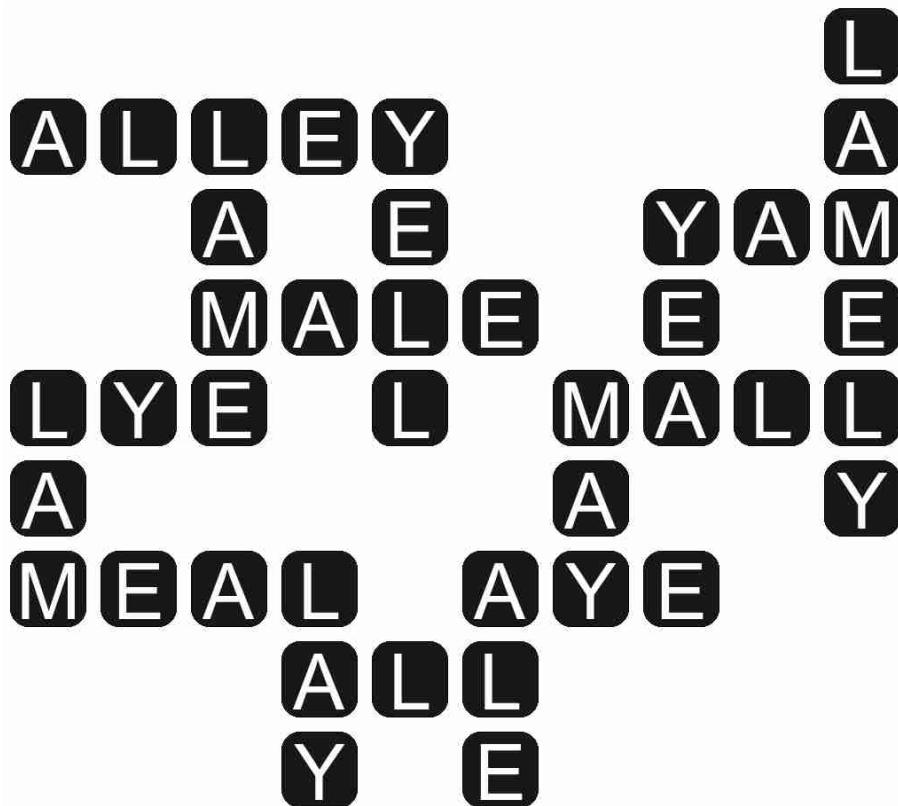
Reaching this point shows that you completed 8,530 words and 33,986 letters.

Word definitions - wordscapes level 765

ALE - An intoxicating liquor made from an infusion of malt by fermentation and the addition of a bitter, usually hops.

ALL - Intensifier.

AYE - Ever, always.

LAY - To place down in a position of rest, or in a horizontal position.

MAY - The hawthorn bush or its blossoms.

YAM - Any climbing vine of the genus Dioscorea in the Eastern and Western hemispheres, usually cultivated.

YEA - Yes.

LAM - Used in the expression on the lam to mean that a person is fleeing law enforcement, possibly in hiding.

LYE - A strong caustic alkaline solution of potassium or sodium salts, obtained by leaching wood ashes. It is much used in making soap as well as its use in biodiesel.

LAME - Unable to walk properly because of a problem with one's feet or legs.

MALE - Someone of male (masculine) gender:.

MALL - A large heavy wooden beetle; a mallet for driving anything with force; a maul.

MEAL - Food that is prepared and eaten, usually at a specific time (e.g. breakfast = morning meal, lunch = noon meal, etc).

YELL - Shout; holler; make a loud sound with the voice.

ALLEY - A narrow street or passageway, especially one through the middle of a block giving access to the rear of lots or buildings.

LAMELY - In the manner of one who is lame.
