This puzzle 22 extra words make it fun to play.

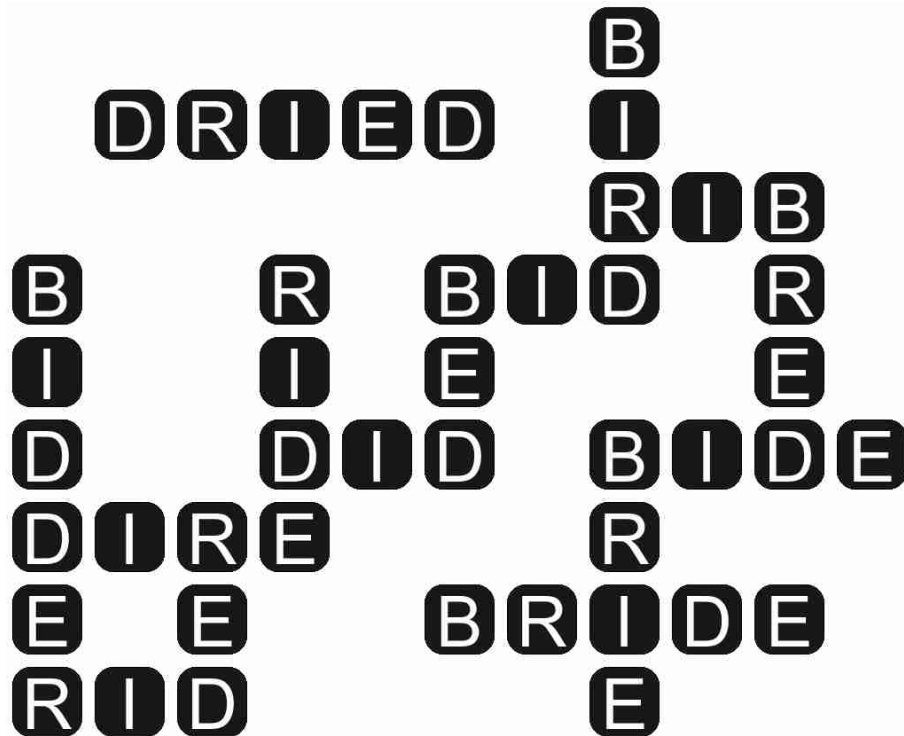
Reaching this point shows that you completed 9,803 words and 39,345 letters.

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# Word definitions - wordscapes level 874

BED - A piece of furniture, usually flat and soft, to sleep on.

BID - To issue a command; to tell.

DID - A Roman numeral representing nine hundred and ninety-nine (999).

RED - Having red as its colour.

RIB - Any of a series of long curved bones occurring in 12 pairs in humans and other animals and extending from the spine to or toward the sternum.

RID - Released from an obligation, problem, etc. (usually followed by "of").

BIRD - A member of the class of animals Aves in the phylum Chordata, characterized by being warm-blooded, having feathers and wings usually capable of flight, and laying eggs.

BRED - Simple past tense and past participle of breed.

DIRE - Ill-boding; portentous.

RIDE - To play defense on the defensemen or midfielders, as an attackman.

BIDE - (chiefly dialectal) To bear; to endure; to tolerate.

BRIE - A variety of soft, mild French cheese made from cow's milk.

BRIDE - A woman who is going to marry or who has just been married.

DRIED - Without water or moisture.

BIDDER - Someone who bids, e.g. at an auction.
