ABLE - A word that is used in place of the letter "A" during communication.

ALLY - To unite, or form a connection between, as between families by marriage, or between princes and states by treaty, league, or confederacy.

BALL - A solid or hollow sphere.

BELL - A percussive instrument made of metal or other hard material, typically but not always in the shape of an inverted cup with a flared rim, which resonates when struck.

YELL - Shout; holler; make a loud sound with the voice.

BALE - Evil, especially considered as an active force for destruction or death.

ABLY - In an able manner; with great ability.

ALLEY - A narrow street or passageway, especially one through the middle of a block giving access to the rear of lots or buildings.

LABEL - A small ticket or sign giving information about something to which it is attached or intended to be attached.

BELLE - An attractive woman.

EYEBALL - The ball of the eye.
