# Word definitions - wordscapes level 953

CON - To study, especially in order to gain knowledge of.

ICE - Water in frozen (solid) form.

ION - An atom or group of atoms bearing an electrical charge such as the sodium and chlorine atoms in a salt solution.

MEN - Plural form of man.

MOB - An unruly group of people.

BIN - A container used for storage.

BIO - A biography.

COB - A male swan.

COIN - A piece of currency, usually metallic and in the shape of a disc, but sometimes polygonal, or with a hole in the middle.

COMB - A toothed implement for grooming the hair.

COME - To move from further away to nearer to.

CONE - A surface of revolution formed by rotating a segment of a line around another line that intersects the first line.

ICON - An image, symbol, picture, or other representation usually as an object of religious devotion.

MINE - Non-premodifying possessive case of I. My; belonging to me; that which belongs to me.

NICE - Nicely.

ONCE - One and only one time.

OMEN - Something which portends or is perceived to portend a good or evil event or circumstance in the future; an augury or foreboding.
